I Nathaniel Smith of Litchfield in the
County of Lincoln and Common welth of
the massachusetts yeoman for and in
consideration of one hundred Dollars to me
in hand paid by John Rogers of
Ware in the County of Barnstable and
Common welth of the massachusetts yeoman
the receipt whereof ^{repay} I for myself my
my heirs administrators and assigns do
acknowledge do sell grant and give up
to the abovesaid Rogers his heirs adm^{rs}
and assigns all my title and title to a tract
of Land situate in Litchfield as folow
Beginning adjoining he man Smiths Lot and
Running W & E Three hundred and twenty
adjoining to Saul Cooks Lot thence running
W & W Eighty rods thence running S & W
Three hundred and twenty rods thence
Running E & E Eighty rods to the first
mentioned bounds containing one hundred
and sixty acres more or less in witness
whereof I here unto set my hand
and seal this third day of may
and in the year of our Lords
one thousand seven hundred and
seventy seven

**John Rogers Deed
Dated May 3, 1797**

Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Smith of Litchfield in the County of Lincoln and Commonwealth of Massachusetts yeoman for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to me in hand by John Rogers of Harwich in the county of Barnstable and Commonwealth of the Massachusetts, yeoman the receipt where of hereby for myself my heirs administrators and asings do acnoledge do sell grant and give up to the above said Rogers his heirs administrators and asines all my rite and title to a tract of land running situate in Litchfield as folows. Beginning ajoyning Heman Smith's lot and runing NNE three hundred and twenty ajoyning to Saul Cooks lot Thense running WNW eighty rods THENSE RUNNING ssw THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY RODS thense running ESE eighty rods to the first mentioned boundary containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less in witness where of I here let my hand and seal this third day of may and in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
