Notes:

- (George Rogers) Margaret was the mother of Sarah (Osgood) Ring, wife of Frances Burnham Ring. The "History of Litchfield" p.101 states: "Margaret Osgood m.(2) John Dinsmore. She died 1828 and he remarried. Dinsmore lives on the Pond Road."

- (Ed Avis) The 1856 Kennebec Co. map shows B.F. Ring (possibly Benjamin Franklin – Daniel's grandson) living near the cemetery

- (George Rogers) The "History of Litchfield" says Frances Burnham Ring lived his whole life on the home place. By 1856 he would have been 67. His son, Benjamin Franklin, could have taken over or this could be a misprint on the map. By 1879 the home place had gone to Frances Burhnam's daughter, Catherine, and her husband Joseph Welch.
