John Rogers Deed Dated May 3, 1797

Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Smith of Litchfield in the County of Lincoln and Commonwealth of Massachusetts yeoman for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to me in hand by John Rogers of Harwich in the county of Barnstable and Commonwealth of the Massachusetts, yeoman the receipt where of hereby for myself my heirs administrators and asings do acnoledge do sell grant and give up to the above said Rogers his heirs administrators and asines all my rite and title to a tract of land running situate in Litchfield as folows. **Beginning ajoyning Heman Smith's lot and runing NNE** three hundred and twenty ajoyning to Saul Cooks lot Thense running WNW eighty rods THENSE RUNNING SSW THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY RODS thense running ESE eighty rods to the first mentioned boundary containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less in witness where of I here let my hand and seal this third day of may and in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
